Notice of Final Decision

Reclamation Permit # 0286

TGC Holdings LTD.

Moonlight Exploration Project

The Nevada Division of Environmental Protection (NDEP) Bureau of Mining Reclamation & Regulation (BMRR) has decided to issue a Reclamation Permit, No. 0286, for an Exploration Project to TGC Holdings LTD. This permit authorizes TGC Holdings LTD. to reclaim the Moonlight Exploration Project. This Project is located in Pershing County, Nevada. The Division has been provided with an application, in accordance with Nevada Revised Statute (NRS) and Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) 519A to assure the Division that TGC Holdings LTD. will leave the project site safe, stable, and capable of providing for a productive post-mining land use.

This permit will become final October 7, 2008. The final determination of the Administrator may be appealed to the State Environmental Commission pursuant to NAC 519A.415. The appeal must be filed by October 6, 2008 and in accordance with Administrative rules of the Environmental Commission.

NDEP received the following written comment from Ms. Darlene Jackson, on August 29, 2008 (Ms. Jackson's comments are in quotations and NDEP/TGC Holdings Ltd. responses are underlined and are in *italics*):

"We have been approached by people from various companies to sell our properties. We have also been approached to give an access permit to TGC Holdings LTD., a Nevada Corporation ... They offered the grand compensation of \$200 for a 5 year period. We have refused offers to sell. I previously refused to sign the Access Permit Agreement from TGC Holdings Ltd. Copy of refusal letter and my letter to sheriff enclosed as you requested. It lists specifics of my concerns. I and my immediate family have owned this property and been Nevada taxpayers since 1958. We bought at the same time ... Total owned by us all is 100 acres ... PLEASE EXPLAIN to me WHY Bureau of Mining and Reclamation, or State of Nevada would, or could have the right to grant access to a holding company to have access to PRIVATE PROPERTY --- Especially since specific access has been denied by me ... WE REQUEST THAT YOU HONOR OUR PRIVATE PROPERTY STATUS and CALL THIS PROCESS TO A HALT ... WE ARE 100% AGAINST THIS."

The Reclamation Permit issued by NDEP BMRR, pursuant to NAC 519A Regulations, only authorizes TGC Holdings Ltd. to properly reclaim the exploration project, to provide for a productive post-mining land use, and to ensure adequate bonding to cover the costs of reclamation. The NAC 519A Regulations do not regulate the operation of exploration sites or where exploration site disturbances can be located. The permit does not serve as a determination of ownership or the validity of any mining claim to which it might relate. The reclamation permit does not grant access to persons who do not otherwise have legal access to any property.

NAC 519A.415 Appeals to commission.

1. Any person aggrieved by:

(a) The issuance, denial, renewal, suspension, modification, condition or revocation of a permit;
or

(b) The issuance, modification or rescission of any other order,
by the state department of conservation and natural resources may appeal to the commission.

2. Any person who requests a hearing before the commission concerning a final decision of the department pursuant to [chapter 519A of NRS](#) may do so by filing a request, within 10 days after notice of the action of the department, on form 3* with the State Environmental Commission, 901 S. Stewart St. Ste. 4001, Carson City, Nevada 89701.

3. The provisions of [NAC 445B.875](#) to [445B.899](#), inclusive, apply to a hearing of the state environmental commission requested pursuant to subsection 1.

4. The commission will affirm, modify or reverse any action of the department, which is appealed to it.
