## Hearing Agenda - Dayton Consolidated Exploration Project Permit No. 0315 Sampling and Analysis Plan

A three-member panel of the State Environmental Commission (SEC) has scheduled a hearing of a contested case regarding Permit No. 0315 Sampling and Analysis Plan issued to Comstock Mining Inc. by the Nevada Division of Environmental Protection. The hearing will begin on April 27, 2012 at 9:00 a.m. The hearing location is at the Nevada Department of Wildlife, Conference Room "A", 1100 Valley Road, Reno, Nevada.

The following items may be taken out of order and/or items may be combined for consideration. Items may also be removed from the agenda or the SEC may delay discussion relating to an item on the agenda at any time. Prior to the commencement and conclusion of a contested case or a quasi-judicial proceeding that may affect the due process rights of an individual, the SEC may refuse to consider public comment. See NRS 233B.126.

### 1. Public Comment (Discussion)

Members of the public will be invited to speak before the SEC; however, no action may be taken on a matter during public comment until the matter itself has been included on an agenda as an item for possible action. Public comment may be limited to five minutes per person at the discretion of the chairperson.
