## 2. Purpose of the Hearing:

The purposed of today's hearing is to consider the Petition for Reconsideration and Rehearing that was filed by the Appellant, Great Basin Mine Watch on July 25, 2006.

That Petition seeks reconsideration of the State Environmental Commission's July 10, 2006 Order, which dismissed the appellant's appeal of a water pollution control permit issued by the Division of Environmental Protection's to AngloGold for the permanent closure of the Big Springs Mine in northern Nevada.

The SEC Order was based on acceptance of a requested Attorney General's Opinion, which found that NRS 233B.127(4) required a public interest group to meet the financial interest requirements established in Nevada law. Accordingly, on July 6<sup>th</sup> of this year the SEC Panel decided that it <u>did not</u> have jurisdiction to hear the above-entitled appeal, and granted the Nevada Division of Environmental Protection's Motion to dismiss the appeal.
