NEVADA STATE ENVIRONMENTAL COMMISSION PUBLIC HEARING

As provided by Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) Chapter 233B and Nevada Administrative Code (NAC), inclusive, a panel of the Nevada State Environmental Commission will conduct an appeal hearing on **Tuesday, June 3, 1997 beginning at 9:30 a.m.**, at the Grant Sawyer State Office Building, Fourth Floor, Nevada Division of Environmental Protection Conference Room located at 4300, 555 East Washington Avenue, Las Vegas, Nevada.

This agenda has been posted at the Grant Sawyer State Office Building in Las Vegas, the Washoe County Library in Reno, the Nevada State Library, and the Division of Environmental Protection Offices in Carson City, Nevada.

The following items will be discussed and acted upon but may be taken in different order to accommodate the interest and time of the persons attending.

I. Appeal Hearing - * ACTION

Alestel Corporation, dba Mesquite Sand & Gravel, Dennis A. Solis, President, P.O. Box 3000-202, Pahrump, Nevada 89041 appeals the Air Quality Notice of Alleged Violations No. 1228 and 1229 dated March 25, 1997 by the Nevada Division of Environmental Protection.

The Division of Environmental Protection, Bureau of Air Quality issued a Notice of Alleged Violation No. 1228 for a minor violation on March 25, 1997 pursuant to Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) 445B.365 for fugitive dust and Notice No. 1229 for a major violation of NAC 445B.227, operation without required equipment. The Division alleges that Mesquite Sand and Gravel, on March 12, 1997, failed to prevent the discharge of fugitive dust from the screening plant. In addition the State alleges that the appellant failed to operate the screen plant with functioning water sprays which were required by Air Quality Operating Permit No. AB1442-0114, requirement A.1.

A three-member panel of the Nevada State Environmental Commission will conduct an appeal hearing in the matter of:

Alestel Corporation, dba Mesquite Sand & Gravel, Dennis A. Solis, President, P.O. Box 3000-202, Pahrump, Nevada 89041 appeals the Air Quality Notice of Alleged Violations No. 1228 and 1229 dated March 25, 1997 by the Nevada Division of Environmental Protection.

The Division of Environmental Protection, Bureau of Air Quality issued a Notice of Alleged Violation No. 1228 for a minor violation on March 25, 1997 pursuant to Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) 445B.365 for fugitive dust and Notice No. 1229 for a major violation of NAC 445B.227, operation without required equipment. The Division alleges that Mesquite Sand and Gravel, on March 12, 1997, failed to prevent the discharge of fugitive dust from the screening plant. In addition the State alleges that the appellant failed to operate the screen plant with functioning water sprays which were required by Air Quality Operating Permit No. AB1442-0114, requirement A.1.

The appellant believes that an unforeseen malfunction occurred at the screen plant and that operations were immediately ceased at the site located in Pahrump, Nevada.
