NEVADA STATE ENVIRONMENTAL COMMISSION PUBLIC HEARING

I. Appeal Hearing - * ACTION

Cyanochem America, L.L.C., Donal Doherty, 24 Cash Drive, Mound House, Nevada, 89407 appeals the order dated March 5, 1999 by the Nevada Division of Environmental Protection.

The Nevada Division of Environmental Protection, Bureau of Air Quality, on March 5, 1999, issued a major violation (No. 1366) and Order of Compliance (No. 99-01) to Cyanochem America, L.L.C. an adhesive manufacturer in regards to Operating Permit No. AP2800-0809. The Bureau of Air Quality, pursuant to Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) 445B.230 and 445B.450 and Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) 445B.395, ordered Cyanochem evaluate the emissions that were released on January 13, 1999 and to discontinue discharge of excess VOC emissions to the ambient air from its Dayton facility.

The appellant asserts that the proposed fine of \$10,000 is out of proportion to the seriousness of the alleged event of January 13, 1999.
