I. Safety-Kleen, 777 Big Timber Road, Elgin, Illinois has petitioned the State Environmental Commission to amend NAC 444.848 and delete portions of NAC 444.8482 pertaining to variances for hazardous waste management facilities.

II. Safety-Kleen, Inc. has petitioned the Environmental Commission for variances to two requirements of the commissions hazardous waste management regulations. These provisions are the hazardous waste facility siting requirements of NAC 444.8456 and the certificate of designation requirements of NAC 444.8458. Safety-Kleen proposes to construct and operate a hazardous waste recycle, service and accumulation center in the City of North Las Vegas at Gowan Road and Bruce Street.
