As provided by Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) Chapter 233B and Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) inclusive, a panel of the Nevada State Environmental Commission will conduct an appeal hearing on December 11, 1992, beginning 8:30 a.m., at the Nevada Public Service Commission located at 4045 South Spencer Dr., Suite A44, Hearing Room B, Las Vegas, Nevada.

The following items will be discussed and acted upon but may be taken in different order to accommodate the interest and time of the persons attending.

I. Appeal Hearing - * ACTION

- A. Conduct an appeal hearing in the matter of the issuance of water pollution permit NEV92033 by the Nevada Division of Environmental Protection for the operation and closure of the waste water treatment ponds at N Tunnels at the Nevada Test Site. The permit issued to the U.S. Department of Energy is being challenged by Citizen Alert, a non profit corporation.

II. Settlement Agreements on Air Quality Violations - * ACTION

The Division of Environmental Protection and the below lettered companies have negotiated settlement agreements for their respective Notices of Alleged Violations which require approval by the Commission.

- A. Saga Exploration Co., Notice of Alleged Violation No. 994.
- B. Premier Services Corporation, Notice of Alleged Violation No. 1000.
- C. Progressive Contracting, Inc., Notice of Alleged Violation Nos. 1003 and 1004.
- D. Concrete Products Company, Notice of Alleged Violation No. 1002.
- E. Coastal Chem Inc., Consent Decree for Notice of Alleged Violation No. 989 as negotiated at the Appeal Hearing on October 28, 1992.
