RE: Notice of Alleged Air Quality Violation Nos. 2455 and 2456  
Class II Air Quality Operating Permit AP3295-1065.02 (FIN A0527)

Dear Ms. Hooper:

In an effort to coordinate an enforcement conference with Nevada Slag, Inc. (Nevada Slag), the Nevada Division of Environmental Protection (NDEP) sent a draft Notice of Alleged Violation and Order (NOAV) via certified mail. The draft NOAV was returned to NDEP as undeliverable, although previous correspondence to the same address had been successfully delivered. NDEP also unsuccessfully attempted to telephone Nevada Slag at a previously working number, but discovered the telephone had been disconnected. As all reasonable efforts to communicate with Nevada Slag were exhausted, NDEP issued NOAV Nos. 2455 and 2456; see attached.

NDEP sent NOAV Nos. 2455 and 2456 via certified mail on December 9, 2013 notifying Nevada Slag of its appeal rights pursuant to NRS 445B.340 and NRS 445B.360. Nevada Slag did not appeal the NOAVs. Therefore, the State Environmental Commission (SEC) will determine the appropriate penalty for the violations contained in the above referenced NOAVs during the May 2, 2014 meeting. This meeting will be held on Friday, May 2, 2014 at 10:00 a.m. in the Bryan Building in Carson City, Nevada (901 S. Stewart Street, 2nd Floor Tahoe Room).

Pursuant to NRS 445B.640(1), the SEC may approve an administrative penalty of not more than \$10,000 per day per violation. During the May 2 meeting, NDEP will provide the SEC with a brief overview of the NOAVs and its recommendation for a total administrative penalty of \$12,600.00, which has been calculated from a penalty matrix previously approved by the Commission.

The SEC will determine the penalty by either accepting NDEP's recommendation or increasing or decreasing the penalty recommendation based on the information presented at the meeting.


Your presence is not required at the May 2, 2014 meeting, although you or a company representative may wish to attend and speak on behalf of Nevada

The SEC may, without further notice, take administrative action against Nevada Slag if the SEC determines that such administrative action is warranted after it considers NOAV Nos. 2455 and 2456.
