
Dear Mr. Dodgion,

I write to you and other members of Nevada State Environmental Commission in opposition to the Petition to Limit Fossil Fuel Emissions filed by Alec and Virginia Looz whose address is 331 Prospect ST., Oak View, California 93022. I urge that you vote to deny this petition for the following reasons;

1. Contrary to what is alleged in the petition submitted, the debate regarding man's role in effecting global climate change in a significant manner has NOT been settled. The whole "Climate-gate" investigation regarding the location of monitoring stations next to exhaust pipes has cast serious doubt as to the validity of the "global warming" advocates data. Just the mere substitution of "global climate change" for the term "global warming" is indicative of this uncertainty among the very experts cited in the petition. Furthermore, the earth's climate has gone through a series of significant climate changes well before the dawn of modern industrialized man. The various glacial and inter-glacial periods along with the wandering of the North and South poles, all well documented in the geologic record, affected Earth's climate in very significant ways. What remains unknown to this day is where in this larger natural cycle of climate change is the Earth currently in? Until we know the answer to this question we can only guess at the relative impact of fossil fuel emissions on global climate change. Therefore, any effort to limit fossil fuel emissions would be a costly, premature, and feeble effort in influencing a much larger natural phenomenon.
2. Adoption of items #4 - **T009-11: Air Pollution Control Adopt by Reference; Greenhouse Gas Permitting** would in essence pre-empt the need for this petition.
3. With the prevailing winds in Nevada coming from the West, how exactly is someone living in California affected by fossil fuel emissions from Nevada and therefore how do they have standing to bring this petition before the Commission?

Therefore, based on the points made above, I urge you to deny the petition referenced above.
