Petition R049-11: This regulation addresses revisions to standards for municipal recycling at apartment complexes and condominiums as required by SB417. SB 417 became effective on June 4, 2011. To implement SB417, the Nevada Division of Environmental Protection (NDEP) proposed minor amendments to existing regulations to require that recycling services be made available to apartment complexes and condominiums, however, the regulation does not mandate that apartment complexes and condominiums, or Multi-Family Dwellings (MFDs), participate in recycling programs. Following the structure in the existing statute, new regulatory provisions relating to recycling services at apartment complexes and condominiums will only apply in counties with populations of 100,000 or more. Accordingly, these regulatory changes provide additional opportunity for residents of apartment complexes and condominium complexes to recycle.
