Petition R130-12 - North Antelope Creek: This regulation establishes appropriate beneficial uses and site-specific water quality standards for North Antelope Creek. North Antelope Creek is a tributary to Rock Creek in the Humboldt River Basin. North Antelope Creek does not have site-specific water quality standards, but is protected via the Tributary Rule (NAC 445A.1239) with the application of water quality standards established for Rock Creek. However, some of the beneficial uses for Rock Creek are not appropriate for North Antelope Creek, particularly municipal and domestic supply and irrigation. Beneficial uses proposed for North Antelope Creek include aquatic life, wildlife, watering of livestock, contact recreation, noncontact recreation and industrial supply.
