## NOTICE OF WORKSHOP

### HAZARDOUS WASTE REGULATIONS

The Nevada Division of Environmental Protection (NDEP) will hold a workshop on proposed regulations concerning hazardous waste. The purpose of the workshop is to inform the public and regulated community about the proposed regulatory changes and solicit comments from interested persons.

The State of Nevada is authorized by the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) to enforce federal hazardous waste regulations. Between July 1, 2005, and July 1, 2006, the EPA approved revisions to existing federal hazardous waste regulations and published them in the Federal Register. The State of Nevada is proposing to modify its state regulations accordingly. The Division of Environmental Protection plans to incorporate these federal revisions into state regulations by adopting the applicable sections of the Federal Register as it existed on July 1, 2006. The proposed state regulations will modify existing state regulations to make them consistent with current federal requirements. The state is also proposing to update and correct additional state hazardous waste regulations.
