**NEVADA STATE ENVIRONMENTAL COMMISSION
SMALL BUSINESS IMPACT DISCLOSURE PROCESS
PURSUANT TO 233B "Nevada Administrative Procedures Act"**

RE: Proposed Amendment to NAC 445B, AIR POLLUTION: EMISSIONS FROM ENGINES, specifically providing waivers from emission standards. (NAC 445B.5808)

By: Nevada Division of Environmental Protection (NDEP), Bureau of Air Quality Planning

Note: Small Business is defined as a "business conducted for profit which employs fewer than 150 full-time or part-time employees" (NRS 233B.0382).

1. Does this proposed regulation impose a direct and significant economic burden upon a small business?

ANSWER: NO. The amendment establishes a waiver request procedure for motor vehicles with a model year 1996 or newer after a sufficient attempt has been made to correct deficiencies that have caused a failure of an emissions inspection.

2. Does this proposed regulation restrict the formation, operation or expansion of a small business?

ANSWER: NO.
