RE: Proposed Amendment to NAC 445B.001-3791 in AIR CONTROLS: AIR POLLUTION (SEC Petition 2008-15)  
By: Nevada Division of Environmental Protection (NDEP), Bureau of Air Pollution Control and Bureau of Air Quality Planning

1. Does this proposed regulation impose a direct and significant economic burden upon a small business?

ANSWER: No. Part of the proposed regulation adds a requirement for certain electric generating units to have best available retrofit technology (BART) installed and to comply with specified emission limitations for NO<sub>x</sub>, SO<sub>2</sub> and PM<sub>10</sub>. This BART requirement only impacts two large companies: Sierra Pacific Resources and its subsidiaries Sierra Pacific Power Company and Nevada Power Company, and Southern California Edison Company. The adopt-by-reference update imposes no economic burdens.

2. Does this proposed regulation restrict the formation, operation or expansion of a small business?

ANSWER: No.
