Note: Small Business is defined as a "business conducted for profit which employs fewer than 150 full-time or part-time employees" (NRS 233B.0382).

1. Does this proposed regulation impose a direct and significant economic burden upon a small business? ANSWER: No, the proposed regulation further defines which engine emission regulations apply to certain motor vehicles. There is no added economic burden to small business other than the cost of an emissions test should a small business register a vehicle affected by the amendment in Clark or Washoe County.

2. Does this proposed regulation restrict the formation, operation or expansion of a small business? ANSWER: No.

3. If **Yes** to either of questions 1 & 2, the following action must be taken:

A. Was a small business impact statement prepared and was it available at the public workshop(s).

B. Attach the Small Business Impact Statement (Part 2) as part of Form #4 upon submission of the proposed regulation to the State Environmental Commission when Form #1 (petition to the Commission) is submitted.
