**RE: Proposed Amendment to NAC 445B in AIR CONTROLS: AIR POLLUTION
By: Nevada Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV)**

1. Does this proposed regulation impose a direct and significant economic burden upon a small business?

ANSWER: No. The proposed regulation establishes a voluntary program which assists regulated fleets, including small businesses, by providing for an electronic method of compliance with the motor vehicle emission testing program. This proposed electronic method of compliance is an alternate to the current method of taking a motor vehicle to an authorized emissions test station.

2. Does this proposed regulation restrict the formation, operation or expansion of a small business?

ANSWER: No.
