## **Notice of Workshop to Solicit Comments on Proposed Amendments to Nevada Administrative Code Chapter 445B, AIR CONTROLS: AIR POLLUTION**

The Nevada Division of Environmental Protection (NDEP) is proposing to adopt regulations amending several portions of Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) 445B. The following workshop has been scheduled to solicit comments from persons interested in the regulatory amendments described below.

**LCB File No. R147-09:** NDEP is proposing to revise the Class I operating permit to construct sections of NAC 445B. The changes establish requirements and timelines for permits issued pursuant to a case-by-case determination for maximum achievable control technologies (MACT). They address the federal case-by-case MACT program requirements and align the timelines for NDEP's case-by-case MACT determination permitting process with NDEP's current Prevention of Significant Deterioration permitting process.

**LCB File No. R148-09:** NDEP is proposing to revise the requirement for SO<sub>2</sub> emission limits at NV Energy's Reid-Gardner Generating Station (RGGS) located in the California Wash northeast of Las Vegas. RGGS is subject to best available retrofit technology (BART) requirements pursuant to U.S. EPA's Regional Haze Rule. Emissions data support the conclusion that BART for SO<sub>2</sub> at RGGS is 0.15 lb/10<sup>6</sup> Btu, on a 24-hour average. These amendments lower the SO<sub>2</sub> emission limits from 0.25 lb/10<sup>6</sup> Btu to 0.15 lb/10<sup>6</sup> Btu, effective January 1, 2015 or 5 years after approval of Nevada's Regional Haze State Implementation Plan by the U.S. EPA, whichever occurs sooner.
