Attached is a [temporary regulation](#) referenced above that was adopted by the State Environmental Commission (SEC) on September 06, 2006. We are filing this regulations as per NRS 233b.070, together with the informational statement prepared pursuant to NRS 233B.0633.

About this Regulation: This temporary regulation amends the Chemical Accident Prevention Program (CAPP) regulation NAC 459.9533. The amendment establishes measures for the prevention of an accidental release to the environment from the storage and handling of mercury at storage facilities in Nevada. Mercury is added to the list of highly hazardous substances in NAC 459.9533 at a threshold quantity of 200,000 pounds or 100 tons.
