ORDER REGARDING BRIEFING SCHEDULE

On October 29, 2018, Avis Budget Car Rental, LLC (ABCR) filed an appeal of the Nevada Division of Environmental Protection's October 18, 2018 letter rejecting Addendum to the Offsite Corrective Action Plan for the Commingled MTBE Plume, dated September 27, 2018.

Pursuant to NAC 445B.8925, it is hereby ORDERED that ABCR shall file an opening brief with the State Environmental Commission ("SEC") on or before Thursday, January 24, 2019. The brief should contain a detailed statement of the issue(s) to be raised during the hearing. It is further ORDERED that the Nevada Division of Environmental Protection shall file a responsive brief on or before Thursday, February 14, 2019. It is further ORDERED that ABCR may file a reply brief on or before Thursday, February 28, 2019. It is further ORDERED that each party shall exchange with each other party, notice of the identity of each person who will offer direct oral testimony at the hearing and each party shall exchange copies of all exhibits the party intends to offer as evidence at the hearing not later than Thursday, February 28, 2019. The parties are encouraged to submit exhibits jointly where possible to avoid duplicate exhibits. Lastly, the appeal hearing in this matter is scheduled for March 14, 2019 and will be located in Carson City.
