On March 7, 2022, Great Basin Resource Watch, filed an appeal of Permit NEV 2020104 issued on February 25, 2022, by the Nevada Division of Environmental Protection to operator Lithium Nevada Corp., for a Groundwater Pollution Control Permit.

On March 11, 2022, Lithium Nevada Corp. filed a Petition for Leave to Intervene with the State Environmental Commission ("Commission").
