Class II Air Quality Operating Permit AP1442-2351 (FIN A0426)

Dear Chris Rose:

On August 19, 2025, the Nevada Division of Environmental Protection (NDEP) held an enforcement conference with Staker and Parson Companies (SPC) to discuss supporting information regarding the draft Notice of Alleged Violation and Order (NOAV) Nos. 3189 and 3190. As a result of that meeting, the NDEP formally issued NOAV 3189 via certified mail on October 1, 2025. See attachment.

Upon formal issuance of the NOAV, NDEP notified SPC of its appeal rights pursuant to NRS 445B.340 and NRS 445B.360. SPC did not appeal the NOAV. Therefore, the State Environmental Commission (SEC) will determine the appropriate penalty for the violation contained in the above-referenced NOAV on Thursday, January 22, 2026, at 9:00 a.m. at the Richard H. Bryan Building, Bonnie B. Bryan Conference Room (first floor) located at 901 South Stewart Street, Carson City. The meeting will also be video-conferenced to the Red Rock Conference room located at the NDEP offices 375 East Warm Springs Blvd., Las Vegas. It will also be held virtually. Pursuant to NRS 445B.640(1) the SEC may approve an administrative penalty of not more than \$10,000 per day per violation. During the January 22, 2026, meeting, NDEP will provide the SEC with a brief overview of NOAV 3189 and the recommendation for administrative penalty of \$10,000. The recommended penalty was calculated using a penalty matrix previously approved by the SEC.

Although your presence is not required at this meeting, you or a representative may wish to attend to speak on behalf of SPC.

The SEC may, without further notice, take administrative action against SPC if the SEC determines that such administrative action is warranted

after it considers NOAV No. 3189.
