4) W.W. Clyde Companies - NOAV Nos. 2794 & 2797 (For Possible Action)

Alleged violation of Class III General Air Quality Operating Permit for temporary Construct Sources Change of Location Approval AP1442-4165 (FIN A1944).

Recommendation: Approve NDEP-recommended penalties for W.W. Clyde Companies in the amount of \$10,000.00 for NOAV No. 2794 and \$4,200.00 for NOAV No. 2797, for a total penalty of \$14,200.00, or take other action as appropriate.

5) Lin Cubing Inc. - NOAV Nos. 2768 & 2771 (For Possible Action)

Alleged violation of Class III Air Quality Operating Permit AP2048-3568 (FIN A0128).

Recommendation: Approve NDEP-recommended penalties for Lin Cubing Inc. in the amounts of \$4,000.00 for NOAV No. 2794 & \$15,000.00 for NOAV No. 2771, for a total penalty of \$19,000.00, or take other action as appropriate.
