## NOTICE OF PUBLIC WORKSHOP Proposed Regulation R050-20 Nevada Division of Environmental Protection June 11, 2020

The Nevada Division of Environmental Protection (NDEP) is proposing to adopt regulation R050-20, which amends Chapter 445A of the Nevada Administrative Code (NAC). Specifically, R050-20 addresses NAC 445A.54032 and NAC 445A.66705.

The proposed regulatory revision, R050-20, makes changes to how a professional engineer is to stamp, sign, and date plans, specifications, and design reports submitted to the Bureau of Safe Drinking Water (BSDW) for review and approval. The revision cites the Nevada Board of Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors stamping and signing regulations (NAC 625). NAC 625 regulates how a professional engineer is to stamp, sign and date documents submitted to a governmental agency.

A public workshop to discuss and hear public comment regarding R050-20 will be held on **Thursday**, **June 11, 2020 from 1:30pm-3:30pm**. Due to COVID-19, the workshop will be held via Lifesize and can be accessed using the information below:
