Dear Ms. Turley:

On January 31, 2022, the Nevada Division of Environmental Protection (NDEP) held an enforcement conference with Kennametal, Inc. (Kennametal) to discuss supporting information regarding the draft Notice of Alleged Violation and Order (NOAV) No. 2905. As a result of that meeting, NDEP formally issued the above NOAV via certified mail on March 21, 2022. See attachment.

Upon formal issuance of the NOAV, NDEP notified Kennametal of its appeal rights pursuant to NRS 445B.340 and NRS 445B.360. Kennametal did not appeal the NOAV. Therefore, the State Environmental Commission (SEC) will determine the appropriate penalty for the violation contained in the above referenced NOAV on **Wednesday, September 20, 2022, at 9:00 a.m. at the Richard H. Bryan Building, Tahoe Conference Room (2nd Floor) located at 901 South Stewart Street, Carson City.**

Pursuant to NRS 445B.640(1) the SEC may approve an administrative penalty of not more than \$10,000 per day per violation. During the September 20, 2022, meeting, NDEP will provide the SEC with a brief overview of the NOAV and the recommendation for an administrative penalty of \$5,040.00 for NOAV 2905. This recommended penalty was calculated using a penalty matrix previously approved by the SEC.

Although your presence is not required at this meeting, you or a representative may wish to attend to speak on behalf of Kennametal.

The SEC may, without further notice, take administrative action against Kennametal if the SEC determines that such administrative action is warranted after it considers NOAV No. 2905.
