R030-11: Biennial Reports by Generators of Hazardous Waste:: This regulations deletes NAC 444.8675 which requires all holders of an active US EPA identification number (regardless of generator status) to file a biennial hazardous waste report with the Nevada Division of Environmental Protection. Deletion of this regulation result in a modest burden reduction for small quantity generators of hazardous waste (who would no longer be required to report) and make the State requirement for biennial hazardous waste reporting consistent with Federal regulations.

Large quantity generators of hazardous waste and transfer/storage/disposal facilities would still be required to submit the biennial hazardous waste report. The Nevada Division of Environmental Protection (NDEP) is required to receive, review and relay hazardous waste biennial report data only for large quantity generators and transfer/storage/disposal facilities to US EPA Region IX, as a condition of the State's hazardous waste program grant with US EPA.
