Dear Mr. Erickson:

On November 7, 2014 and January 29, 2015, the Nevada Division of Environmental Protection (NDEP) held enforcement conferences with Clean Dried Processing, Inc. (CDPI) to discuss supporting information regarding the draft Notices of Alleged Violation and Orders (NOAV) Nos. 2524, 2525, 2526 and 2529. As a result of those meetings, NDEP formally issued NOAV Nos. 2524, 2526 and 2529, issuing NOAV No. 2525 as a Warning only. See attached.

NDEP sent NOAV Nos. 2524 through 2526 via certified mail on December 17, 2014, and NOAV No. 2529 via certified mail on February 13, 2015 notifying CDPI of its appeal rights pursuant to NRS 445B.340 and NRS 445B.360. CDPI did not appeal the NOAVs. Therefore, the State Environmental Commission (SEC) will determine the appropriate penalty for the violations contained in the above referenced NOAVs on Wednesday, October 14, 2015 at 9:00 a.m. at the Nevada Legislative Building located at 401 South Carson Street, Room 2135.

Pursuant to NRS 445B.640(1), the SEC may approve an administrative penalty of not more than \$10,000 per day per violation. During the meeting, NDEP will provide the SEC with a brief overview of the NOAV and its recommendation for an administrative penalty of \$14,075.00. This recommended penalty was calculated using a penalty matrix previously approved by the SEC.

Although your presence is not required at this meeting, you or a representative may wish to attend to speak on behalf of CDPI.

The SEC may, without further notice, take administrative action against CDPI if the SEC determines that such administrative action is warranted after it considers NOAV Nos. 2512.
