Dear Mr. Murphy:

The Nevada Division of Environmental Protection – Bureau of Air Pollution Control (BAPC) alleges that Florida Canyon Mining, Inc. (Florida Canyon) has violated a condition of Class II Air Quality Operating Permit AP1041-0106.03.

The attached Notice of Alleged Air Quality Violation and Order (NOAV) No. 2554 alleges that Florida Canyon has violated a condition of Class II Air Quality Operating Permit AP1041-0106.03. Specifically, it is alleged that Florida Canyon has Violated NAC 445B.275 due to failure to comply with the requirements for recordkeeping, monitoring, reporting or compliance certification contained in section IV.C. of the permit. As defined by Section 2 of NAC 445B.281 Violations: Classification; administrative fines, NOAV No. 2554 constitutes three minor violations and one major air quality violation.

As was discussed during the conference held on May 11, 2015, the BAPC makes recommendations to the Nevada State Environmental Commission (SEC) as to what an appropriate penalty may be for an air quality violation. The BAPC will be recommending a penalty of \$2,585.00 to the SEC. The penalty recommendation is based on the use of the Administrative Penalty Table for emission violations related to source test and adjusted by the Penalty Matrix.

An appeal of NOAV No. 2554 may be requested pursuant to Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) 445B.360 and SEC administrative rules. A copy of SEC Appeal Form #3 is enclosed. Appeals must be received within 10 days of receipt of this notice, pursuant to NRS 445B.340. Appeals are processed through Valerie King, the Executive Secretary for the SEC, at 901 South Stewart Street, Suite 4001, Carson City, Nevada, 89701-5249. It is alleged that the following regulation was violated by the person named in this notice:

NAC 445B.275 Violations: Acts constituting; notice. 1. Failure to comply with any requirement of NAC 445B.001 to 445B.3689, inclusive, any applicable requirement or any condition of an operating permit constitutes a violation. As required by NRS 445B.450, the Director shall issue a written notice of an alleged violation to any owner or operator for any violation, including, but not limited to:

(e) Failure to comply with any requirement for recordkeeping, monitoring, reporting or compliance certification contained in an operating permit.

It is alleged that the following act or practice constitutes the violation:

Failure to report annual emissions information for four systems on the Annual Emissions Report (AER).

Evidence:

Florida Canyon Mining, Inc. (Florida Canyon) operates a gold mining and processing facility in Imlay, Pershing County, Nevada under Class II Air Quality Operating Permit AP1041-0106.03, issued by the Nevada Division of Environmental Protection - Bureau of Air Pollution Control (BAPC) on November 16, 2009.

On March 3, 2015 the BAPC received an AER from Florida Canyon for calendar year 2014. Upon review of the AER by the BAPC on April 23, 2015 it was noted that information was not provided for System 09 - Dore Furnace, System 10 -Carbon Kiln, System 11 - Mercury Retorts and System 12 - Steam Boiler. Air Quality Operating Permit AP1041-0106.03 requires that production and emissions information for each system be submitted to the BAPC by March 1st for each calendar year.

On May 11, 2015 the BAPC and Florida Canyon held and enforcement conference to discuss whether the issuance of the subject Notice of Alleged Air Quality Violation and Order (NOAV) was or was not warranted. Florida Canyon stated that there were several personnel issues and changes recently that led to the failure to report the proper information to the BAPC. The BAPC is aware that this may have been a contributing factor however all documentation that was submitted to the BAPC was signed by the Responsible Official for the facility and therefore is subject to the review of management. Based on the information provided by Florida Canyon during the conference the BAPC is issuing NOAV No. 2554.

Evidence Continued:

In accordance with <u>NAC 445B.281 Violations: Classification; administrative fines</u>, the alleged failure to report permit required operating parameters constitutes three minor violations and one major violation. NOAV No. 2554 for failure to report, represents Florida Canyon's third air quality violations in the past 60 months.
