# Notice of Workshop to Solicit Comments on a Proposed New Program in Nevada Administrative Code Chapter 445B - Air Pollution

The Nevada Division of Environmental Protection (NDEP) is proposing to amend NAC 445B by adding a new regulation to establish an Emission Reduction Credit (ERC) program for the creation, banking, transfer and use of ERCs. Permanent Regulation P2015-03: The NDEP is proposing a new, voluntary program intended to assist in growth and economic development in areas designated nonattainment for a national ambient air quality standard(s). The program will provide offsets for a new major stationary source wishing to locate in a nonattainment area or for an existing facility to make a major modification, while at the same time providing air quality benefits. In a nonattainment area, if a facility reduces emissions through an operational change, a reconfiguration or a shutdown, and as long as the emission reductions are surplus (as defined in the regulation), the program will allow the facility to request credit for the reductions and bank a reduced portion of the credit for future use or sale. The program includes provisions for the transfer and redemption of banked credits.
