NOTICE OF WORKSHOP TO SOLICIT COMMENTS ON A PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO NEVADA'S WATER CONTROLS: NOTIFICATION OF RELEASE OF HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCE (NAC 445A.3475)

The Nevada Division of Environmental Protection (NDEP) Bureau of Corrective Actions (BCA) is proposing regulations relating to the Spill Hotline that will allow for online and faxed notification of releases of hazardous substances. The proposed revision to **NOTIFICATION OF RELEASE OF HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCE** provides that the Director of the State Department of Conservation and Natural Resources may be notified of the release of certain hazardous substances through an online reporting system, fax, or by telephone. for the reporting of a release of a hazardous substance by an online reporting system at www.ndep.gov, faxed to (775) 687-8335, or by telephone at (888) 331-6337, for in-state calls, or (775) 687-9485, for in-state or out-of-state telephone calls, within one working day. The revision will be under **NAC 445A.3475 Provision of notice.** Releases included under **NAC 445A.3473** will still require reporting by telephone at (888) 331-6337, for in-state telephone calls, or (775) 687-9485, for in-state or out-of-state telephone calls (24 hour spill hotline). Releases included under **NAC 445A.3473** are: a) In a quantity equal to or greater than that which is required to be reported to the National Response Center pursuant to 40 C.F.R. Part 302, b) Involves any amount of a hazardous substance that is released to surface water, or c) Threatens a vulnerable resource.
