On July 26, 2016, the Nevada Division of Environmental Protection (NDEP) held an enforcement conference with B.R. Constructors to discuss supporting information regarding the draft Notice of Alleged Violation and Order (NOAV) No. 2567. As a result of that meeting, NDEP formally issued the above NOAV. See attached.

NDEP sent NOAV No. 2567 via certified mail on August 12, 2016, notifying B.R. Constructors of its appeal rights pursuant to NRS 445B.340 and NRS 445B.360. B.R. Constructors did not appeal the NOAV. Therefore, the State Environmental Commission (SEC) will determine the appropriate penalty for the violations contained in the above referenced NOAV on Wednesday, November 16, 2016 at 10:00 a.m. at the Bryan Building, Tahoe Conference Room (2nd Floor) located at 901 South Stewart Street, Carson City.

Pursuant to NRS 445B.640(1), the SEC may approve an administrative penalty of not more than \$10,000 per day per violation. During the November 16 meeting, NDEP will provide the SEC with a brief overview of the NOAV and its recommendation for an administrative penalty of \$1,400.00. This recommended penalty was calculated using a penalty matrix previously approved by the SEC.

Although your presence is not required at this meeting, you or a representative may wish to attend to speak on behalf of B.R. Constructors.

The SEC may, without further notice, take administrative action against B.R. Constructors if the SEC determines that such administrative action is warranted after it considers NOAV No. 2567.
