1. Does this proposed regulation impose a direct and significant economic burden upon a small business?

<u>ANSWER:</u> No. These amendments establish requirements and timelines for permits issued pursuant to a case-by-case determination for maximum achievable control technologies (MACT) under the federal National Emissions Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants rules. Federal rules already require sources to submit a case-by-case MACT application; therefore, there will be no added economic impacts to the regulated industry due to NDEP's proposed revisions to the Class I operating permit to construct program.

2. Does this proposed regulation restrict the formation, operation or expansion of a small business?

ANSWER: No.
