SUMMARY OF MEETING MINUTES

Proposed Regulation Petitions LCB File No. R112-22 Bureau of Water Pollution Control

Call to order and introductions

Elizabeth Kingsland called the meeting to order and introduced Brandon Beach, Management Analyst from the Bureau of Water Pollution Control (BWPC); Deputy Administrator Jennifer Carr, BWPC Chief Andrew Dixon, BWPC Program Supervisor Donette Barreto, and BWPC Program Supervisor Katrina Pascual. Elizabeth listed the locations where the meeting notice and agenda were posted. She stated that the purpose of the workshop was to receive comments from all interested parties regarding the proposed changes to the regulations. Comments will be summarized and provided to the State Environmental Commission at their meeting on December 14th, 2022.

Presentation and discussion of proposed regulation petition R112-22

Elizabeth Kingsland presented the proposed amendments to NAC 445A. She discussed why the BWPC collects fees and the need for the fee increases based on the consumer price index, reviews of revenue and expenditure projections, staff time studies, and increased demand. She discussed the increases in 445A-232 (Discharge Permits), 445A-268 (General Permits), 445A-872 (Underground Injection Control Permits), and 445A-963 (On-Site Sewage Disposal Systems). She stated that the Agency determined that impacts on small businesses are not anticipated. She provided Brandon Beach's contact information for written comments, and stated they are due by October 15th, 2022. She then opened the meeting to public comments and questions.

Comments, Questions and Answers

Jason Reed, NV Energy: Are the 3% increases beginning July 2026, are those in perpetuity? Elizabeth stated, yes, that is correct and that they would be posted annually on the website. Brandon added that the yearly analysis would occur around January because annual fee invoices go out in March.

Katrina Pascual, BWPC: State that wastewater operators attending can contact the BWPC for a certificate for a contact hour towards their continuing education.

Christene Klimek: Where is the copy of the Small Business Impact Statement? Brandon answered that it is posted on our website, ndep.nv.gov under Water Pollution Control on the What's New page.

Joe: When do the stormwater fees increase? Elizabeth and Brandon stated that there is an initial increase in 2023, and the 3% yearly increases begin in 2026.
